

Does Vaccine Choice Affect Me?

Yes, if your job is dependent on getting a flu shot.

- Flu shot efficacy is as low as 10% and is the most injurious
- Studies show vaccination does not lower spread of flu among patients
- Hospitals receive higher reimbursement from CMS for vaccine compliancy. This is not about health, it's about money.

Yes, if you value informed consent.

- Risks are rarely presented alongside benefits.
- A child can receive up to 10 vaccines in a single visit, and parents who wish to delay or separate vaccines are kicked out of practices for not complying.
- Insurance bonuses for high vaccine rates create a conflict of interest. A practice with 500 patients, earns a \$200,000 annual bonus.
- Vaccine mandates undermine informed consent. No choice? No conversation.

Yes, if you want government out of your healthcare decisions.

- The Michigan health department usurped state statute, requiring parents to explain their vaccine decisions to someone outside their home and doctor's office in exchange for a vaccine waiver.
- Parents who opt their child out of one or more vaccines (or even just a booster) must sign an incriminating state-issued waiver form in order for their child to attend school. Natural immunity also requires a waiver.
- Medical exemptions are reviewed and approved by a bureaucrat, not a medical doctor who knows your health situation or history.
- Allergies and past reactions do not support a medical exemption.
- Healthy, uninfected, partially vaccinated children are held out of school for weeks by the health department while a fully vaccinated, yet still susceptible, child can remain in school.

Yes, if you believe vaccines carry even a slight risk.

- Risk of injury varies from 0% to 100%. You have the right consider individual factors and susceptibilities. Where there's risk, there must be choice.
- A federally-operated Vaccine Injury Court for vaccine injury compensation has granted \$3.6+ billion in compensation to claims.
- For some, injuries include high fevers, encephalopathy, paralysis, seizures, and death.
- Vaccine manufacturers aren't liable for injuries due to the 1986 National Childhood Vaccine Injury Act.

What is Vaccine Choice?

Choice includes full, partial, delayed, and selective vaccination. It means no legal mandates or requirements, allowing for you and your healthcare provider to develop a healthcare plan that is best for you, your environment, lifestyle and health history.
